**Showers. Thunderstorm.**

**Adelaide area**  
Partly cloudy. Scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. Winds northwest to southwesterly averaging up to 25 km/h tending westerly 20 to 30 km/h during the afternoon then increasing to 25 to 40 km/h later in the evening.

**Thursday 29 September**

 **Min 10 Max 17**  
**A few showers.**

**Adelaide area**  
Partly cloudy. Scattered showers. Isolated thunderstorms during the morning. Winds west to southwesterly averaging 30 to 45 km/h decreasing to 20 to 30 km/h by early evening.

**Friday 30 September**

 **Min 11 Max 16**  
**Showers.**

**Adelaide area**  
Cloudy. Scattered showers. The chance of thunderstorms about the hills and southern suburbs during the afternoon. Winds west to southwesterly averaging up to 30 km/h tending south to southwesterly up to 20 km/h later in the evening.

**Saturday 1 October**

 **Min 9 Max 17**  
**Shower or two clearing.**

**Adelaide area**  
Partly cloudy. Isolated showers during the morning. Winds south to southeasterly averaging 10 to 20 km/h.

**Sunday 2 October**

 **Min 7 Max 19**  
**Mostly sunny.**

**Adelaide area**  
Mostly sunny. Winds east to northeasterly averaging 10 to 20 km/h.

**Monday 3 October**

 **Min 11 Max 24**  
**Partly cloudy.**

**Adelaide area**  
Partly cloudy. Isolated showers and the chance of thunderstorms. Winds north to northeasterly averaging up to 30 km/h becoming northeasterly up to 20 km/h during the evening.

**Tuesday 4 October**

 **Min 12 Max 23**  
**Partly cloudy.**

**Adelaide area**  
Partly cloudy. Isolated showers and the chance of thunderstorms. Winds north to northeasterly
