Technical Officer – Trainees

Trainees with the Bureau of Meteorology can look forward to an interesting, exciting and challenging career, with the opportunity to travel, gain broad field experience and to work with a wide range of modern scientific/technical equipment, much of which is computer based.

Your first step to this progressive career is to apply now for engagement as a Trainee Technical Officer (Observer). If selected, you will undertake an intensive 29 week training course at the Bureau's Training Centre in Melbourne. Course completion is followed by posting and on-the-job training at any of the Bureau's Meteorological Offices in Australia. Postings are determined following recruitment.

You will need to have a Diploma, or equivalent, with studies (at least to first year level) in a physical science with some mathematics. Additional IT studies are desirable. You will also need to be able to demonstrate flexibility, independence and resourcefulness, be able to work shiftwork and be willing to accept postings to isolated locations.
