Electronic Systems Technical Officer in Training

Your first step to this progressive career is to apply now for engagement as a Trainee APS (Technical). If selected, you will undertake up to 30-weeks training spread over a 10 month training period at the Bureau's Training Centre in Melbourne, interspersed with on-the-job training at the Regional Maintenance Centre located in the State for which you are recruited. The training is scheduled to commence in late January 2009. On successful completion, you will advance to Technical Officer Level 2 (with opportunity for advancement to Level 3) and undertake maintenance and repair of Bureau equipment throughout the State.
