



Trainee Technical Officer (Electronics)

A successful applicant for the position of Trainee Technical Officer (Electronics) will be expected to have the following qualifications, attributes and qualities.

Eligibility: Qualification requirements

Completion of a Diploma of Engineering (Electronics), or equivalent qualification.

Selection Criteria

You are required to submit a brief statement of claims against the Selection Criteria with your application.

The statement should relate your qualifications, skills, abilities, experience and personal qualities to each criterion. *Try to limit each claim to one or two brief paragraphs.*

1. A good academic record, which demonstrates an ability to adapt to new concepts and complex work. (Work experience can be taken into account where relevant.)
2. Demonstrated motivation towards developing a career in Electronics with the Bureau of Meteorology; including a willingness to undertake maintenance and installation trips to isolated areas within the relevant State or region.
3. Knowledge of general electronic theory and practice, relative to electronic and electro-mechanical experience, and demonstrated ability to use PC-based record-keeping applications.
4. A methodical approach to analysing technical problems, which demonstrates an aptitude for fault finding and repair work in a safe work environment.
5. Good interpersonal skills including effective oral and written communication skills and the ability to work in a team environment.
6. An understanding of the Bureau's Social Justice Strategy and a commitment to apply them in practice.

NOTE: All criteria are important. Failure to demonstrate satisfactory claims against one or more of the criteria may be sufficient to exclude applicants from further consideration.

Conditions

Engagement is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) probation;
- (b) citizenship;
- (c) formal qualifications;
- (d) character clearance; and
- (e) health clearance.
