The closest sunshine and evaporation data are available from Nuriootpa about 40 kilometres to the south. These can give an indication of sunshine and evaporation in many cases, but it should be noted that Eudunda lies on the opposite side of the ranges to Nuriootpa. Daily sunshine is affected by cloud, and evaporation is affected by cloud, relative humidity, temperature and wind strength during the day.
