Case Summary

1. [Removed With Consent] is an s 47F employee in the Bureau of Meteorology (the Bureau) who commenced with the Bureau in s 47F role is as s 47F in the s 47F s 47F and performs duties as s 47F . s 47F
2. It is alleged that on a number of occasions in s 47F whilst logged on to a Bureau computer [Removed With Consent] accessed a website, "Pornhub", which hosts pornographic videos. It is also alleged that [Removed With Consent] installed the program "HideMyAssVPN" to hide s 47F web browsing from s 47F employer.
3. [Removed With Consent] was appointed as the MPC Inquiry Officer on s 47F . The inquiry was conducted in accordance with the MPC Procedures available at: <http://www.apsc.gov.au/mer-it/code-of-conduct-investigations-by-the-merit-commissi-oner>.
4. The specific allegations were set out in the Notice of Suspected Breach (NOSB) provided to [Removed With Consent] on s 47F . Relevant evidence was attached to the NOSB and provided to [Removed With Consent] . [Removed With Consent] provided a written response on s 47F
5. On s 47F the Inquiry Officer requested the Bureau provide further information, largely of a technical nature, arising out of [Removed With Consent] response to the NOSB. Mr Suthagar Seevaratnum, the SES officer responsible for the Information Systems and Services Division in the Bureau, provided a response to the request on s 47F . This response also identified new evidence and an additional, related allegation which had not previously been known in relation to [Removed With Consent] [Removed With Consent] was given an opportunity to provide further comment on the technical matters set out in the Bureau's response and in relation to the new evidence and allegation .
