## How to use this document

This document is divided into two sections. The first section deals with changes to the list of persons named in the Water Regulations 2008. The second section deals with changes to the list of commercially sensitive sites.

Section 1 begins with Table 1 showing the most recent changes to the names of organisations, which appear in alphabetical order. It then reproduces the list of organisations named in the Water Regulations 2008 (Table 2). Names that have been changed since 15 July 2009 are highlighted and marked by an asterisk.

At the end of Section 1 are two tables. The first of these (Table 3) lists in alphabetical order all organisations whose details have changed in the Regulations since 15 July 2009, along with the relevant State/Territory and the categories in which the organisation is listed. It provides information about the changes made and the date of the changes.

Table 4 lists all organisations that have been removed from the Regulations, the reason for their removal and the date of the change.

Section 2 reproduces the list of commercially sensitive sites (Table 5). Sites that have been changed are highlighted and marked by an asterisk. Those changes will be detailed in tables at the end of the list, in the manner described above for the list of persons.
