Units of measurement

Except where noted, **temperature** is given in degrees Celsius (°C), **rainfall** in millimetres (mm), and **wind speed** in kilometres per hour (km/h).

Observation times and periods

Each station in Australia makes its main observation for the day at 9 am local time. At this time, the precipitation over the past 24 hours is determined, and maximum and minimum thermometers are also read and reset. In this publication, the following conventions are used for assigning dates to the observations made:

Maximum temperatures are for the 24 hours *from* 9 am on the date mentioned. They normally occur in the afternoon of that day.

Minimum temperatures are for the 24 hours *to* 9 am on the date mentioned. They normally occur in the early morning of that day.

Mean temperatures are the average of the daily maximum and daily minimum temperatures.

Daily rainfall is for the 24 hours *to* 9 am on the date mentioned. This means a significant fraction of the rain may have occurred on the previous calendar day.

Monthly rainfall is for the period from 9 am on the last day of the previous month to 9 am on the last day of this month.

Maximum daily wind gusts are in the 24 hours from midnight to midnight.

Climatological values

The climatological averages shown in the text and tables are generally long-term means based on observations from the years 1961–1990. They are not shown for sites with less than 25 years of record in that time, as they cannot then be calculated reliably. Climatological extremes are generally taken from all available years of record; the number of years can vary markedly from site to site.

Records

The tables of records are not exhaustive, as they only show sites with at least 30 years of record. This may exclude locations where a new site has been established; this means even some major cities and towns may not be listed.

Maps

The temperature and rainfall maps are intended to give an overview of the country. There could be discrepancies between the values shown on these maps and those at individual locations, as a result of the way the maps are generated. Overview

- Nationally, April was the fifth-warmest on record for Australia
- Both mean maximum and mean minimum temperatures above average for Australia as a whole
- Mean maximum temperature above to very much above average for the northern and western halves of Australia, and along the east coast; cooler than average for much of the southeast
- Mean minimum temperatures above to very much above average for most of Australia; close to average for large parts of the mainland southeast
- April rainfall below average for the country as a whole
- Rainfall above average for much of southeastern Australia, parts of the Kimberley and the north of the Northern Territory
- Rainfall below average for the west and south of Western Australia, much of eastern Queensland, and parts of coastal New South Wales

In this table *Hottest day* is the highest daily maximum temperature, *Coldest night* is the lowest daily minimum temperature, *Wettest day* is the highest daily rainfall total, *Warmest overall* is the highest mean monthly temperature, *Coollest overall* is the lowest mean monthly temperature and *Wettest overall* is the highest total monthly precipitation.

Significant weather

Victoria

Floods, strong winds and snow

A strong cold front which crossed Victoria on the 3rd, brought a sharp decrease in temperatures to the State, and snow to the Victorian Alps; Mount Hotham reported 5 cm of snow.

Heavy rainfall and strong winds on the 5th resulted in flooded roads, fallen trees and damage to buildings; the SES responded to more than 400 calls for help.

Strong squally winds followed the passage of a cold front on the 11th; the strongest winds for the month in Victoria were recorded on this day, with gusts of 131 km/h reported at Wilsons Promontory Lighthouse; the SES received more than 450 calls, mostly for fallen trees.

More snow arrived in the Alpine area at the end of the month, in a wake of a vigorous cold front which brought low temperatures; Mount Buller reported 10 to 15 cm of snow on the 30th.

Tasmania

Strong winds at times

Winds were stronger than average at most locations, particularly across the central highlands. Wind run for April was the highest for at least ten years at many sites, including kunanyi (Mount Wellington Pinnacle), Launceston Airport, Devonport Airport, Butlers Gorge, Strahan Aerodrome, and Maatsuyker Island Lighthouse. The strongest gust was 146 km/h at Hogan Island on the 5th.

New South Wales and ACT

Strong winds and snow

Several cold fronts crossed New South Wales and the ACT during the month. While they brought substantial rain and cool conditions to inland areas, they did not generally reach coastal areas. The most significant cold front was on the 30th. This brought strong winds and a drop in temperature, with significant snowfall over the Alpine region. The most recent comparable event in New South Wales in April occurred on 26 to 27 April 2008. Some sites had their coldest April day on record, and for many towns in north and west it was their coldest April day since the 1950s or 1960s. The major cold outbreak began to affect the ACT on the 30th, with snow falling on higher ground. Canberra Airport's maximum of 9.7 °C on the 30th was the coldest April day, and the earliest date in autumn with a maximum below 10 °C, since 1952.

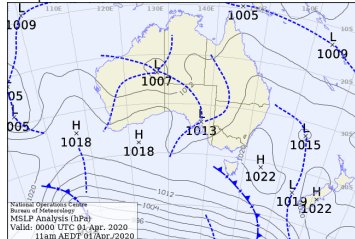
Western Australia

Persistent warm days at the start of the month

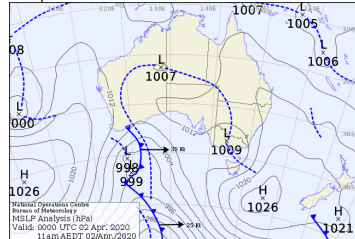
Daytime temperatures were persistently warm across the southwest over the 7th to the 11th. This peaked on the 11th, with Perth Metro reaching a new April record maximum of 39.5 °C, and other stations in the Perth area also exceeded their previous April daily maximum temperatures by over 1 degree. It was also very warm across the northwest at times during April. Argyle Aerodrome had a new Australian April minimum temperature record with 31.1 °C on the 2nd, and the 42.0 °C at Mandora on the 26th is the first instance anywhere in Australia of 42+ degrees after ANZAC Day.

Synoptic summary

At the beginning of the month, broad low pressure troughs were located over Central and southeast Australia. A pair of cold fronts swept across southeast Australia from the 3rd. The second cold front was more vigorous, extending north into southern Queensland, with a pre-frontal trough reaching northwest Queensland and across the base of the Top End in the Northern Territory by the 4th. The system moved offshore by the 6th.

Meanwhile, tropical cyclone *Harold* had developed in the northern Coral Sea on the 4th, and tracked south-southeast into the central Coral Sea over the following days. The system had no impact on the Australia continent.

In the west, broad low pressure troughs lingered over northwest Western Australia until around the middle of the month, with surface troughs located over

northwest and northern Australia, and a surface trough extended down through inland eastern Australia on the 10th.

A pair of cold fronts approached the southeast on the 12th, then much of the country was under the influence of high pressure until around the 15th, before another pair of cold front tracked across far southeast Australia on the 16th and 17th.

Several cold fronts tracked across southwest and southeast Australia for the remainder of the month. At the end of the month, a complex low pressure system developed over Tasmania and an associated cold front moved over the southeast.

High pressure systems over the Tasman Sea during the month extended a ridge along Queensland's east coast, with moist onshore flow extending across the tropical north coast throughout the month.

Temperatures

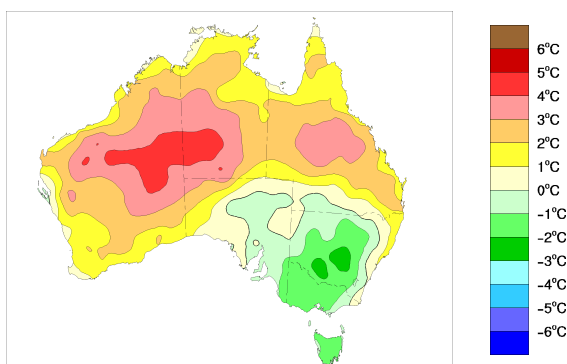
It was the fifth-warmest April on record for Australia as a whole, with the national mean temperature 1.64 °C warmer than average for April. The mean temperature was amongst the ten warmest on record for April for Western Australia, the Northern Territory, and Queensland.

Nationally, the mean maximum temperature was the eighth-warmest on record for April at 1.64 °C above average, while the mean minimum temperature was the fifth-warmest at 1.63 °C above average. The mean maximum and mean minimum temperature were both amongst the top five warmest on record for April for the Northern Territory and Western Australia, while the mean maximum temperature was the seventh-warmest on record for Queensland, and the mean minimum temperature was the equal-seventh-warmest on record for Tasmania.

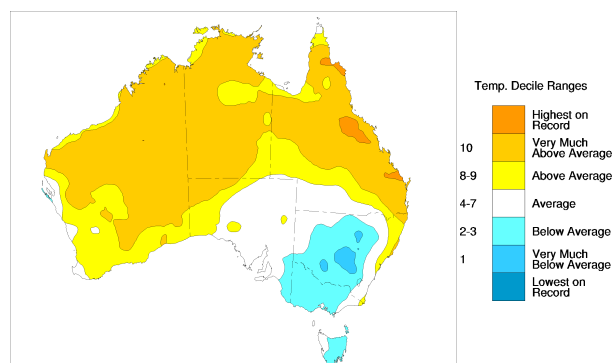
Maximum temperatures

Maximum temperatures for April were above or very much above average across nearly all of Western Australia, the Northern Territory, and most of Queensland except some areas of the inland south and southwest. A number of stations in Queensland had record-high April mean daily maximum temperatures. Warmer than average maxima were also observed along the coast of New South Wales and in the west of South Australia.

The mean maximum temperature for the month was below average for large areas of southeastern Australia away from the east coast, including nearly all of Victoria except East and South Gippsland, the far southeast of South Australia, much of New South Wales inland of the ranges and away from the northwest, and nearly all of Tasmania except the far northwest.

The warm month for the north and west also included some periods of very warm individual days. A large number of stations in Western Australia observed late-season maximum temperature records, with a number of them exceeding previous late-season records multiple times during the month.

At the start of the month, daytime temperatures were generally warmer than usual across northern Australia. In contrast, days were cooler than usual from central to southeast Australia due to periods of rain and the passage of a cold front.

Maximum temperatures were well above average across the southwest from the 7th to the 13th. A number of sites in southwest Western Australia had their hottest April day on record on the 11th, including Perth Airport, which reached 39.5 °C, exceeding the previous record (37.7 on 8 April 2013) by more than 1 degree. The heat extended eastwards into southeast Western Australia and southwest South Australia on the 14th and 15th, and much of Australia reporting above average maximum temperatures. Some stations in northern and eastern Queensland and northeastern New South Wales also had record warm April days around the middle of the month.

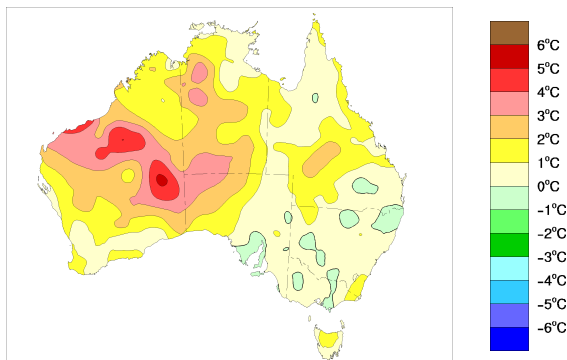
It was generally warmer than usual across northern and inland Australia until cooler days were experienced across southern Australia in the last part of the month. The passage of a strong cold front across southeast Australia in the last few days of the month saw maximum temperatures more than 8 °C

below average across the southern half of Australia, and more than 10 °C below average in parts of northwestern New South Wales.

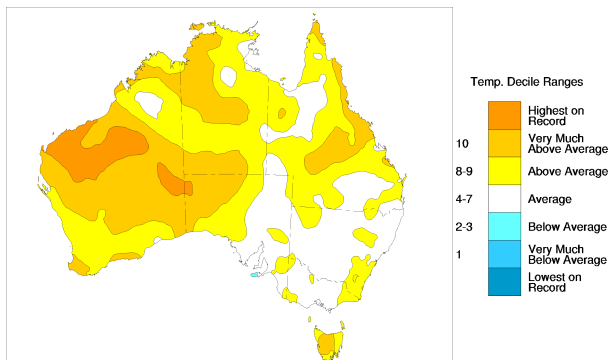
Minimum temperatures

The mean minimum temperature for the month was above or very much above average for most of Western Australia, including a region of highest on record mean minimum temperatures for April in the northwest of the State.

Mean minimum temperatures for the month were also above to very much above average for nearly all of the Northern Territory, western and central South Australia, much of Queensland except in parts of the inland south, west, and Gulf Country.

Minimum temperatures were also below average for all of Tasmania, and areas along the border of South Australia and Victoria, between far eastern Victoria and the central coast of New South Wales, and areas in the northern inland slopes in New South Wales.

Minimum temperatures were mostly warmer than usual across northern much of the continent at the start of the month. A few stations in the Northern Territory and New South Wales observed record warm nights for April early in the month.

Around the 12th, a large high pressure system over the Great Australian Bight kept skies clear and nights cool, with much of eastern Australia reporting minimum temperatures more than 4 °C below average under around the middle of the month.

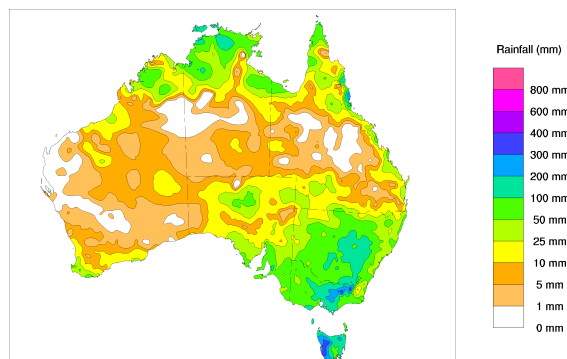
Minimum temperatures were warmer than usual across large parts of the west from the middle until late in the month.

The passage of a strong cold front across the southern and southeast Australia at the end of the month saw nights much cooler than usual across southwest and southern parts of Australia.

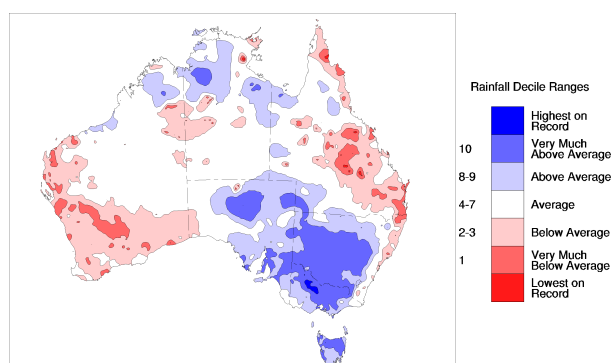
Rainfall

April rainfall was 21 % below average for Australia as a whole. However, rainfall was above average for much of southeastern Australia.

Rainfall was above to very much above average for most of Victoria, Tasmania, New South Wales on the inland side of the ranges, most of eastern to central South Australia, and parts of far southwestern Queensland. Both Victoria and Tasmania ranked amongst the ten wettest on record for April.

Rainfall for April was below average for the west and south of Western Australia, much of eastern Queensland, and parts of coastal New South Wales between the Illawarra and the northeast.

At the start of the month, a broad convective cloudband stretched from central to southeast Australia producing widespread light to moderate falls over northern South Australia, southern parts of the Northern Territory, much of New South Wales,

southwest Queensland, and much of Victoria and Tasmania. The heavy rainfall in the first week of the month saw a number of stations in eastern Tasmania, Victoria, New South Wales, and a few in South Australia observe their wettest April day on record.

Onshore flow produced isolated showers and thunderstorms in northern Australia and the north tropical Queensland coast. Tropical convection brought thunderstorms and showers, and moderate falls to much of northern Australia in the first part of the month. Tropical cyclone *Harold* developed in the Solomon Sea on the 1st and intensified while moving east-southeast to the south of the Solomon Islands. Severe tropical cyclone *Harold* made landfall on Vanuatu on the 6th as a category 5 storm producing very destructive winds and heavy rainfall to Solomon Islands and Vanuatu.

The passage of a strong cold front on the 11th also brought some heavy rainfall, with a couple of daily records for April in New South Wales, and strong and squally winds causing some damage.

Severe thunderstorms developed over the Central Highlands and Capricornia districts in Queensland on the afternoon of the 19th, and produced giant hail (8 to 10 cm in diameter) around Rockhampton and Yeppoon.

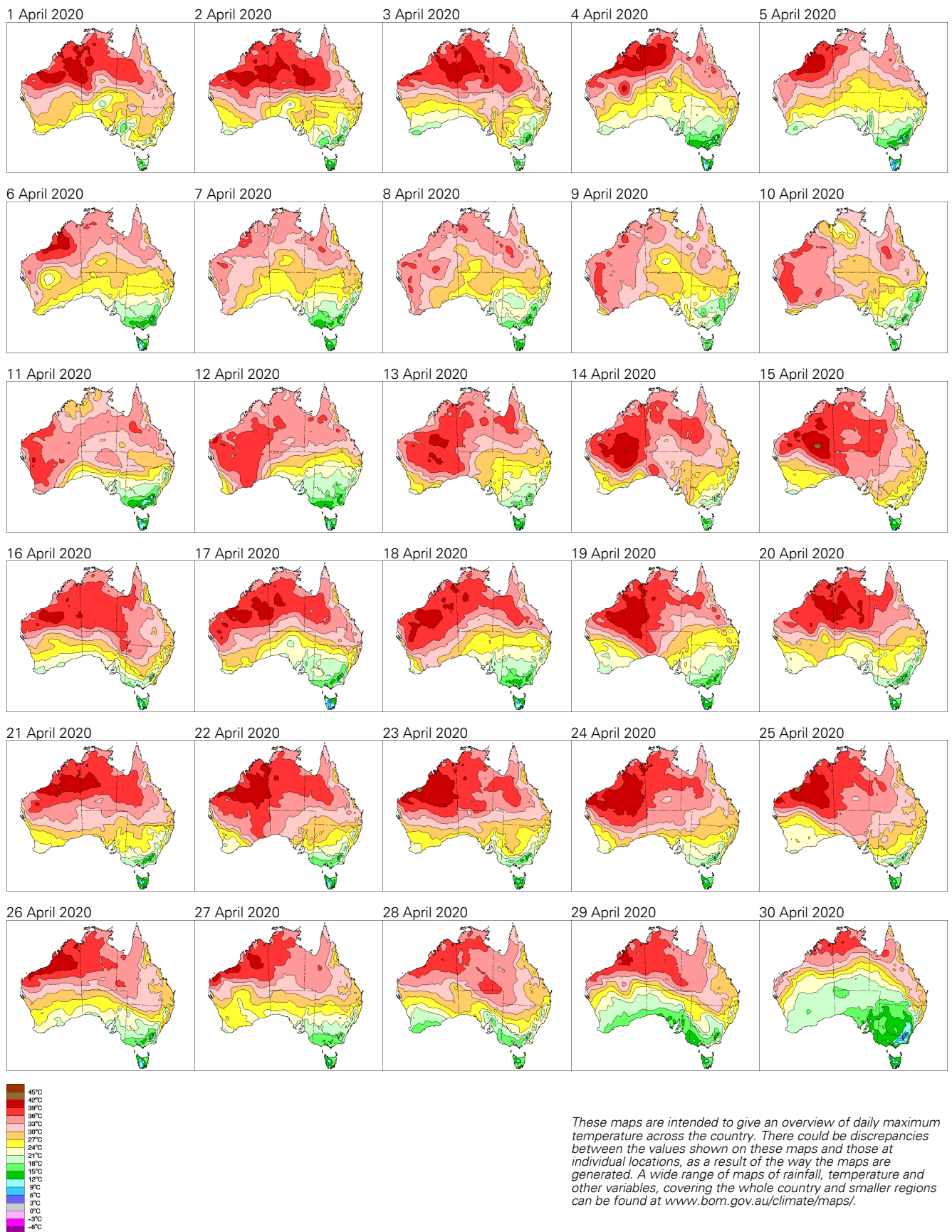
Several cold fronts tracked across southeast Australia, and generated widespread light to moderate falls in Tasmania.

By mid-month, a slow-moving high pressure system in the northern Tasman Sea extended a ridge along the east coast, with showers in a moist onshore flow producing moderate falls across the north tropical Queensland coast, Cape York Peninsula, and the coastal Top End of the Northern Territory.

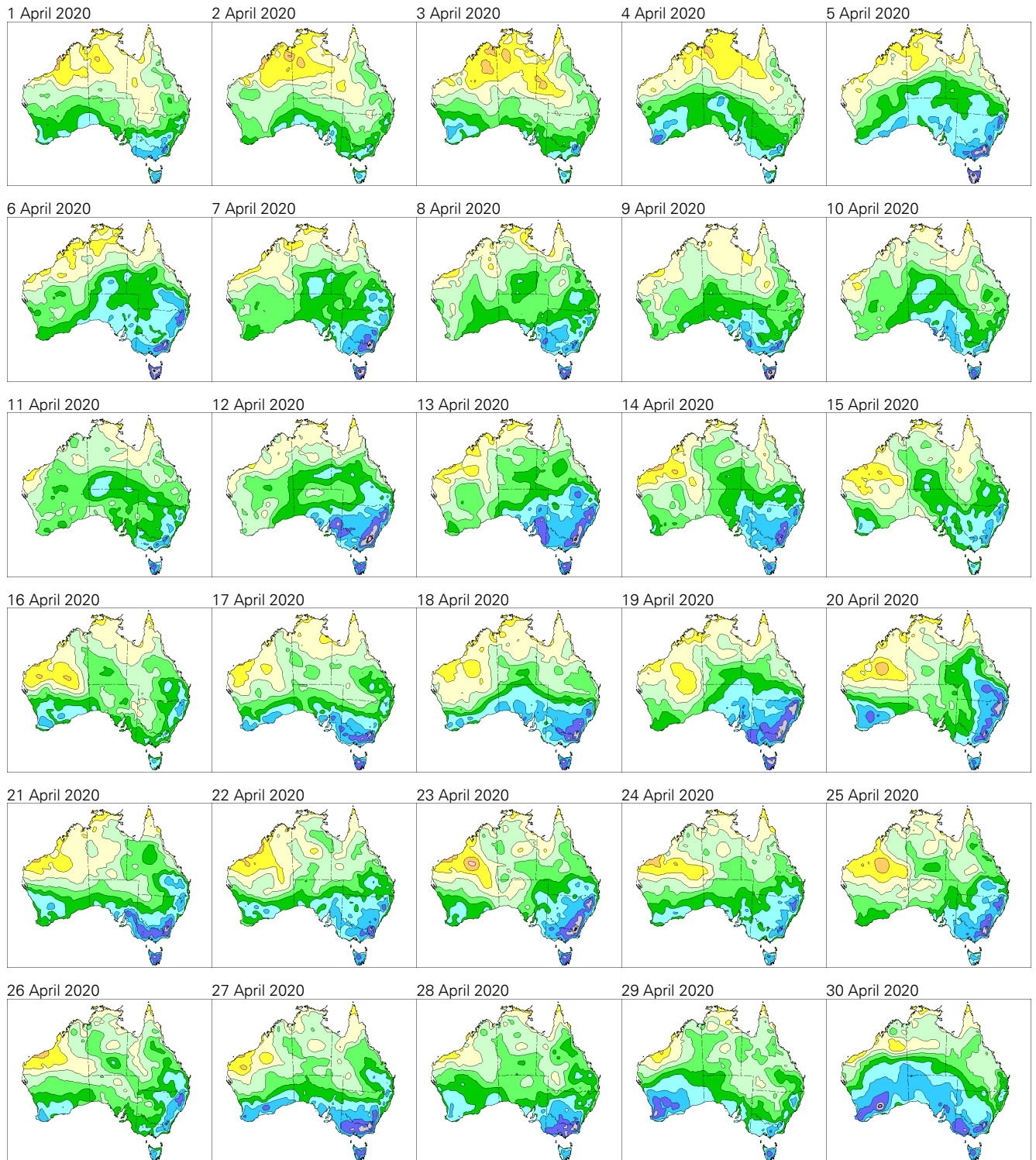
A series of cold fronts in the last week of the month again brought significant rainfall to parts of the southeast. Flooding, fallen trees, and disruptions to transport were reported with both events. In Victoria, Tasmania, and New South Wales a number of stations observed their wettest April on record.

Daily maximum temperature maps

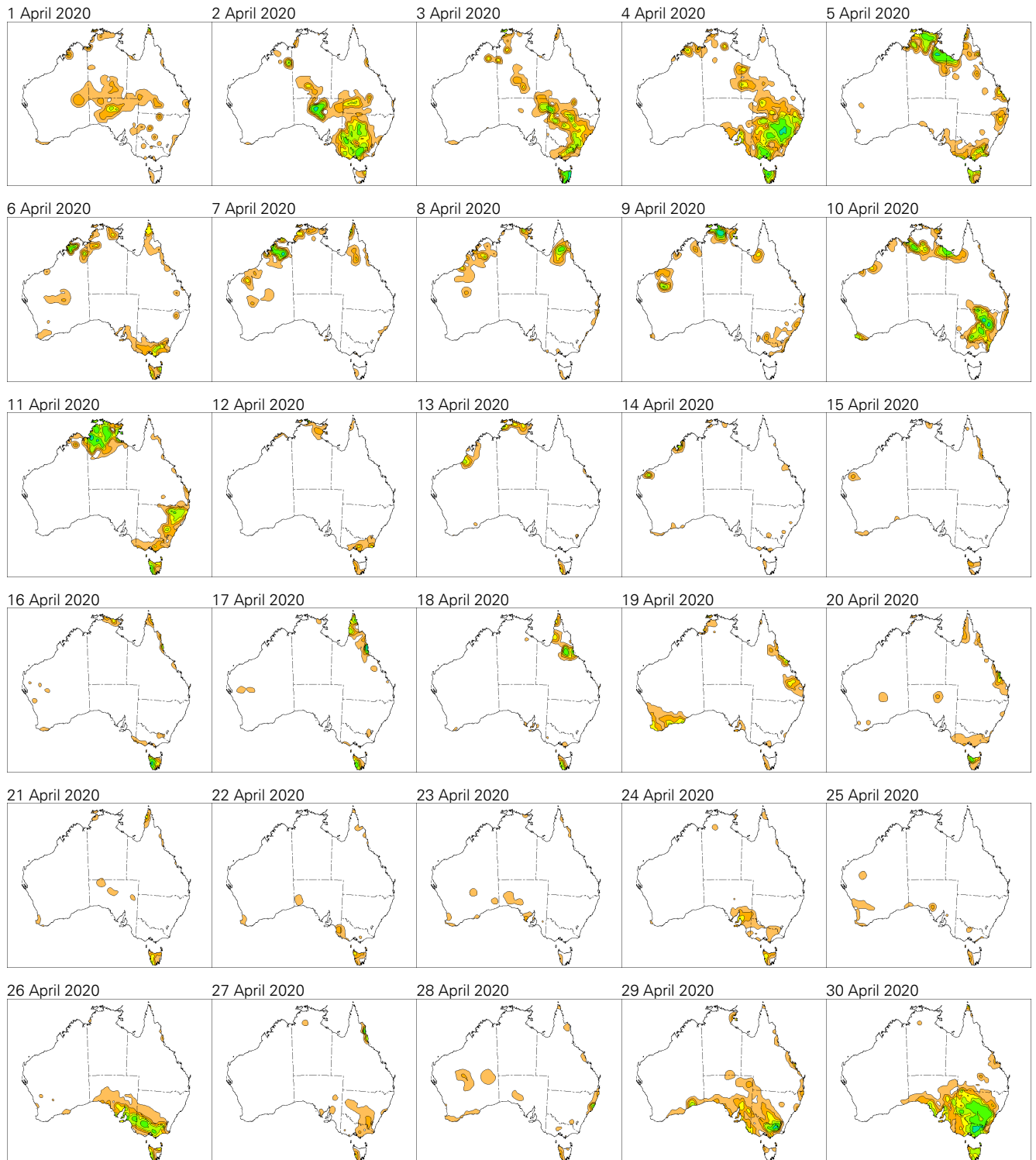


Daily minimum temperature maps

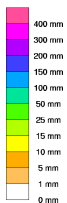
