### February 2011



The *Monthly Weather Review - Queensland* is produced twelve times each year by the Australian Bureau of Meteorology's Queensland Climate Services Centre.

It is intended to provide a concise but informative overview of the temperatures, rainfall and significant weather events in Queensland for the month.

To keep the *Monthly Weather Review* as timely as possible, much of the information is based on electronic reports. Although every effort is made to ensure the accuracy of these reports, the results can be considered only preliminary until complete quality control procedures have been carried out. Major discrepancies will be noted in later issues.

## Units of measurement

Except where noted, **temperature** is given in degrees Celsius (°C), **rainfall** in millimetres (mm), and **wind speed** in kilometres per hour (km/h).

## Observation times and periods

Each station in Queensland makes its main observation for the day at 9 am local time. At this time, the precipitation over the past 24 hours is determined, and maximum and minimum thermometers are also read and reset. In this publication, the following conventions are used for assigning dates to the observations made:

**Maximum temperatures** are for the 24 hours *from* 9 am on the date mentioned. They normally occur in the afternoon of that day.

**Minimum temperatures** are for the 24 hours *to* 9 am on the date mentioned. They normally occur in the early morning of that day.

**Mean temperatures** are the average of the daily maximum and daily minimum temperatures.

**Daily rainfall** is for the 24 hours *to* 9 am on the date mentioned. This means a significant fraction of the rain may have occurred on the previous calendar day.

**Monthly rainfall** is for the period from 9 am on the last day of the previous month to 9 am on the last day of this month.

**Maximum daily wind gusts** are in the 24 hours from midnight to midnight.

## Climatological values

The climatological averages shown in the text and tables are generally long-term means based on observations from all available years of record, which vary widely from site to site. They are not shown for sites with less than 9 years of record, as they cannot then be calculated reliably. Climatological extremes are generally taken from available observations from all available years of record. The number of years can vary substantially from site to site.

## Overview

- Severe Tropical Cyclone Yasi crossed the coast near Mission Beach on the 3rd, then affected the northern parts of the state early in the month
- Major rain events occurred over the southwest districts at the beginning of the month by Ex-Tropical Cyclone Anthony and again from the 13th to the 18th by a deep trough
- A deep trough caused areas of shower and thunderstorm activity over the southeast, central and western districts on the 21st
- Below average February rainfall over most eastern parts of the state while above average over the northwest
- Slightly above the average February maximum temperatures over the southern districts while below average over the central interior and northern parts
- Similar pattern for the minimum temperatures

The current La Niña event has shown signs of weakening during February. Two February daily rainfall records and nine monthly rainfall records occurred over the tropical areas close to the location of the monsoon trough and the path of Ex-Severe-TC Yasi early in the month. Two of the daily records happened over the southern parts of the Central Coast and this was related to a cut off low near the Central Coast during the 8th and 9th. The state-averaged rainfall total for February was 132.87 mm, slightly above the long-term average of 115.61 mm.

Queensland state-averaged mean temperature for February was 0.02 °C above the long-term (1961–1990) average of 28.19 °C. The state-averaged maximum temperature was 0.14 °C below the long-term mean of 33.99 °C, while the state-averaged minimum temperature was 0.18 °C above the long-term mean of 22.39 °C.

## Significant weather

### Tropical Cyclone Yasi

Tropical Cyclone Yasi formed in the Fijian area of responsibility near the end of January and quickly intensified from a Category 3 to a Category 4 on the 1st of February before accelerating towards the tropical Queensland coast. Yasi upgraded to a marginal Category 5 system in the morning of the 2nd of February and made landfall on the southern tropical coast near Mission Beach between midnight to 1 am early on the 3rd of February. Severe Tropical Cyclone Yasi maintained a strong core with damaging winds and heavy rain, tracking westwards across the northern parts of the state and finally weakened to a tropical low near Mount Isa around 10 pm on the 3rd of February.

Yasi was one of the most powerful cyclones to have affected Queensland since records commenced. Previous cyclones of a comparable measured intensity include the 1899 cyclone Mahina in Princess Charlotte Bay, and two cyclones of 1918 at Mackay (January) and Innisfail (March). ## Synoptic summary

At the beginning of the month, the remnants of Ex-Tropical Cyclone Anthony, as a low, weakened, moved rapidly and reached the southwest corner of the state during the first two days of the month. Rain and thunderstorm areas with moderate falls dominated the southwest of the state during this period.

Tropical Cyclone Yasi formed in the Fijian area of responsibility near the end of January and quickly intensified from a Category 3 to a Category 4 on the 1st of February then accelerated its movement towards the tropical Queensland coast. Tropical Cyclone Yasi upgraded to a marginal Category 5 system during the morning of the 2nd of February and made landfall on the southern tropical coast near Mission Beach between midnight to 1 am early on the 3rd. Severe Tropical Cyclone Yasi maintained a strong core with damaging winds and heavy rain, tracking westwards across the northern parts of the state and finally weakened to a tropical low near Mount Isa around 10 pm on the 3rd. A barograph at the Tully Sugar Mill recorded a minimum pressure of 929 hPa as the cyclone eye passed over the suggesting wind gusts of about 285 km/h were possible. Significant wind damage was reported between Innisfail and Townsville. A 5 metre tidal surge was observed at the Department of Environment and Resource Management storm tide gauge at Cardwell. Widespread rain areas with moderate to heavy rainfalls had remained over the northern parts of the state during the 4th and 5th as the Ex-Tropical Cyclone Yasi moved into the NT as a low pressure system.

On the 5th and 6th, a middle to upper level trough over the western Coral Sea moved into eastern Queensland, leading to an enhanced area of rain showers and thunderstorms over the central districts and into the Wide Bay and Burnett district. Showers then eased over the southeast of the state.

A surface trough over the southern interior on the 7th shifted towards the northeast and merged with a cut off low near the central coast. As a result, scattered showers and thunderstorms over the southern interior parts of the state on the 7th were pushed over the southeast of the state, the Capricorn Coast and the Wide Bay areas, with some moderate to heavy falls during the 8th and 9th.

On the 10th, a high over the Tasman Sea had extended a ridge across the southeast of the state. Fine weather conditions dominated the southeastern parts of the state over the following days while some isolated showers persisted along the southeast coast.

A deep and slow moving trough remained over the southwestern border area during the 13th to 18th and produced scattered showers and thunderstorms with some moderate to heavy falls over the southwestern and western regions.

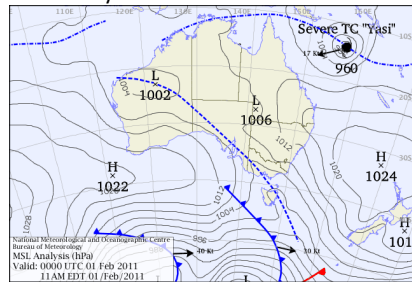
From the 13th to 16th, an upper low over the Queensland central coast maintained unstable conditions along the coast and adjacent inland parts with some showers and thunderstorms over the area.

A deep surface trough entered into the southwestern districts on the 19th and triggered scattered showers and thunderstorms over the southern and southwestern districts on the 21st. This trough pushed the scattered showers and thunderstorms over the southeast quadrant and into most central and northwestern parts of the state on the 22nd.

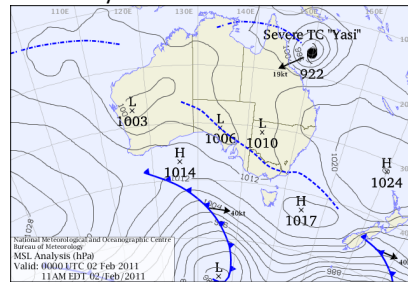
Rain areas and storm activity persisted over the northern parts of the state, particularly over the Cape York Peninsula, for the rest of the month due to the monsoon trough over the northern tropics. Fine weather conditions dominated the southern and most of the central parts of the state during this period, apart from some very isolated showers over the southeast.

## Temperatures

The mean temperature for Queensland in February 2011 was 28.21 °C, which is 0.02 °C above the long-term average 28.19 °C.

The warmest on average was Birdsville Airport with 32.8 °C, followed by Bedourie Police Station with 31.7 °C, then Boulia Airport with 30.7 °C.

The coolest on average was Applethorpe with 21.2 °C, followed by Stanthorpe Leslie Parade with 21.9 °C, then Jimna Forestry with 22.4 °C.

### Maximum temperatures

The February mean maximum temperature were 1 to 2 °C above their long-term averages over most of the southeastern districts, apart from the southeast coast districts which were only less than 1 °C warmer. Most of the central coast, central interior and southern interior also had their mean maxima slightly, or less than 1 °C, warmer than their long-term means. For the southwestern corner of the state, the tropical east coast and most of the Cape York Peninsula, their mean maxima were slightly, or less than 1 °C, below the long-term means, while the northwestern corner was 2 to 4 °C cooler than the long-term averages.

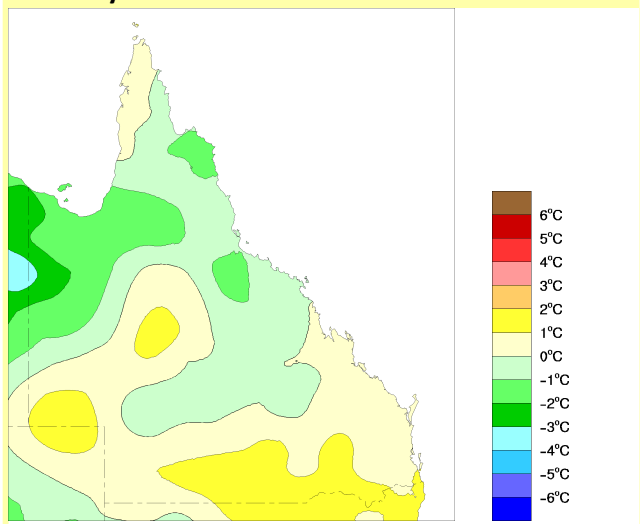
The hottest day was at Birdsville Airport with 42.5 °C on the 19th, followed by Bedourie Police Station with 42.1 °C on the 1st, then Birdsville Airport with 41.8 °C on the 18th.

The warmest days on average were at Birdsville Airport with 39.3 °C, followed by Bedourie Police Station with 38.6 °C, then Winton Airport with 37.9 °C.

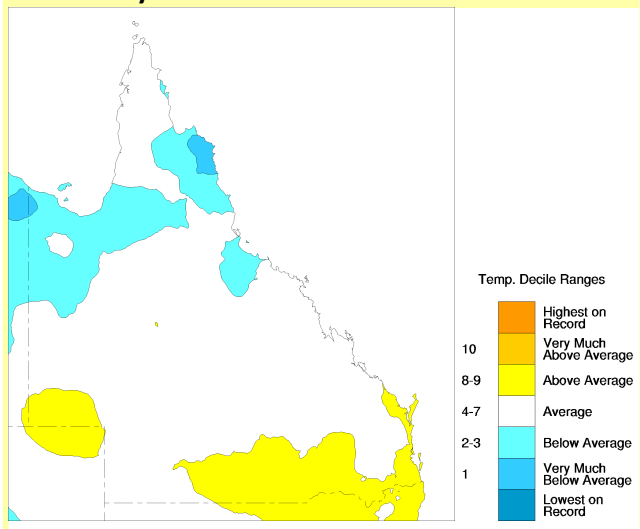
The coolest day was at Applethorpe with 19.9 °C on the 8th, followed by Stanthorpe Leslie Parade with 20.3 °C on the 8th, then Toowoomba Airport with 20.5 °C on the 8th.

The coolest days on average were at Maleny Tamarind St with 26.4 °C, followed by Applethorpe with 26.8 °C, then Jimna Forestry with 27.0 °C.

### Minimum temperatures

The February mean minimum temperatures were 1 to 2 °C above the long-term means over the southern districts and along the central coast, while only slightly (less than 1 °C) warmer over the southeast coast, the southern parts of the tropical coast as well as the northern Cape York Peninsula. For most northern and central interior parts, the monthly mean minima were near or 1 °C below the long-term means.

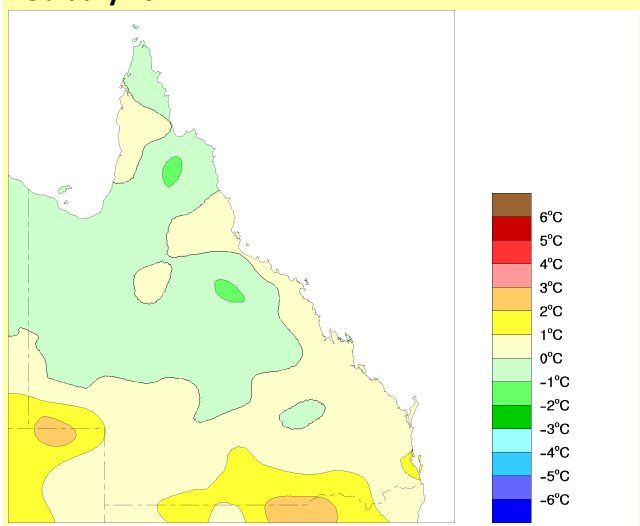
The coldest night was at Stanthorpe Leslie Paradewith 8.7 °C on the 24th, followed by Applethorpe with 9.0 °C on the 24th, then Applethorpe with 11.2 °C on the 23rd.

The coolest nights on average were at Applethorpe with 15.5 °C, followed by Stanthorpe Leslie Paradewith 16.2 °C, then Warwick with 17.5 °C.

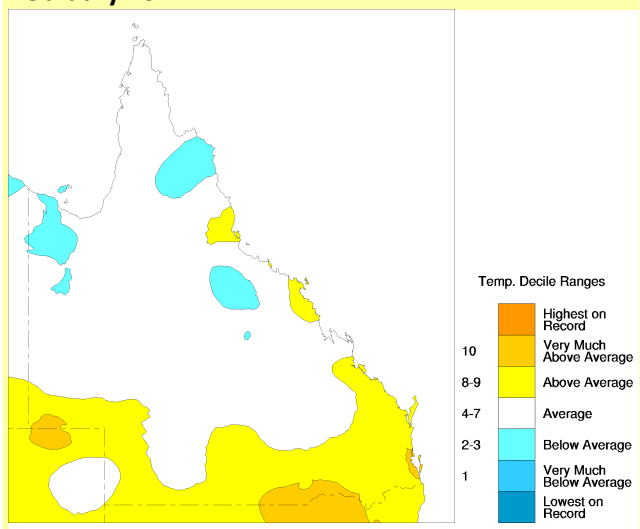
The warmest nights on average were at Birdsville Airportwith 26.2 °C, followed by Coconut Island and Sweers Island with 25.2 °C, then Low Isles Lighthousewith 25.0 °C.

The warmest night was at Birdsville Airportwith 30.2 °C on the 19th, followed by Birdsville Airportwith 29.7 °C on the 1st, then Birdsville Airportwith 29.5 °C on the 3rd.

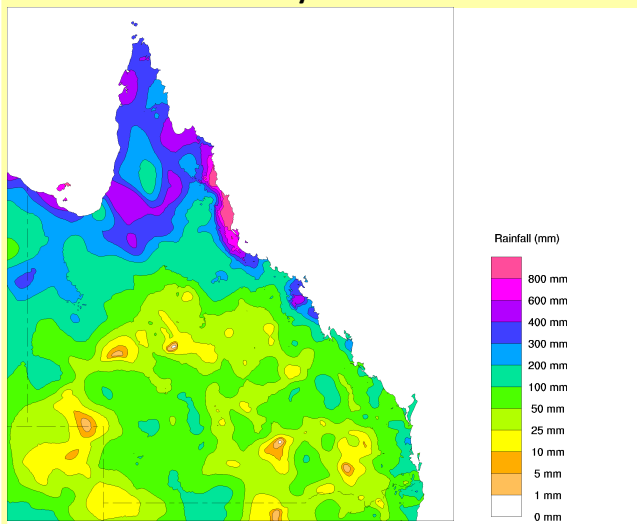
## Rainfall

During the February, rainfall totals were below the long-term averages over most southeastern parts of the state, the central districts and the western half of the Cape York Peninsula. Areas with total rainfalls very much below the average (decile 1) were over parts of the eastern Darling Downs, the Central Coalfields and the southwestern parts of Cape York Peninsula. The western districts and the tropical coasts were wetter than their long-term February averages. Areas with total rainfalls very much above the average (above decile 9) were over the northwestern districts and along the tropical coasts.

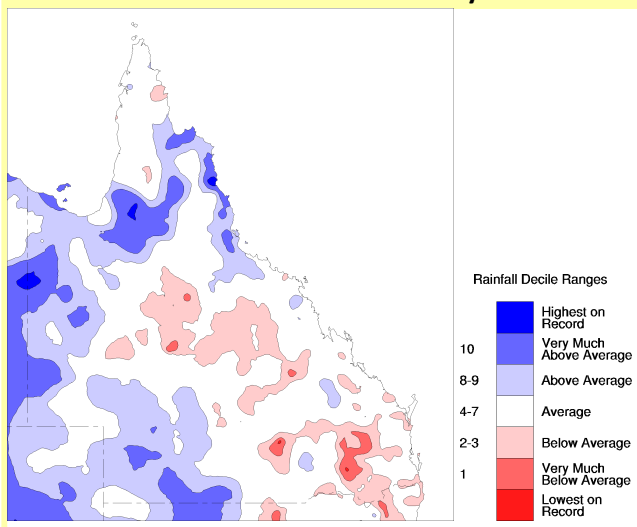
The wettest overall was Bellenden Ker Top Stn with 2298.0 mm, followed by Whyanbeel Valley with 1727.2 mm, then Daintree Village with 1639.0 mm.

The wettest single day was at Hawkins Creek with 464.0 mm on the 3rd, followed by Zattas Alert with 407.0 mm on the 3rd.

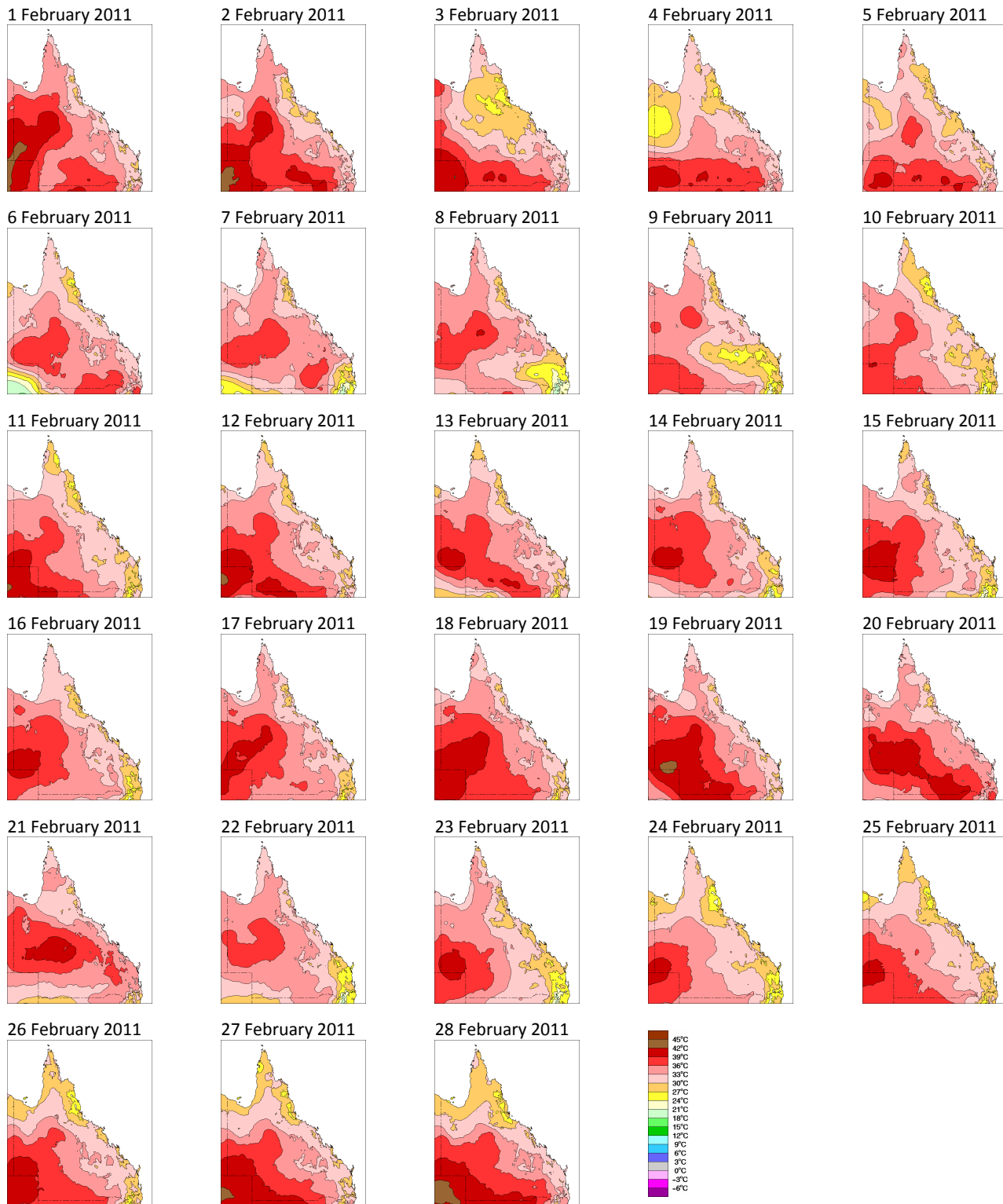

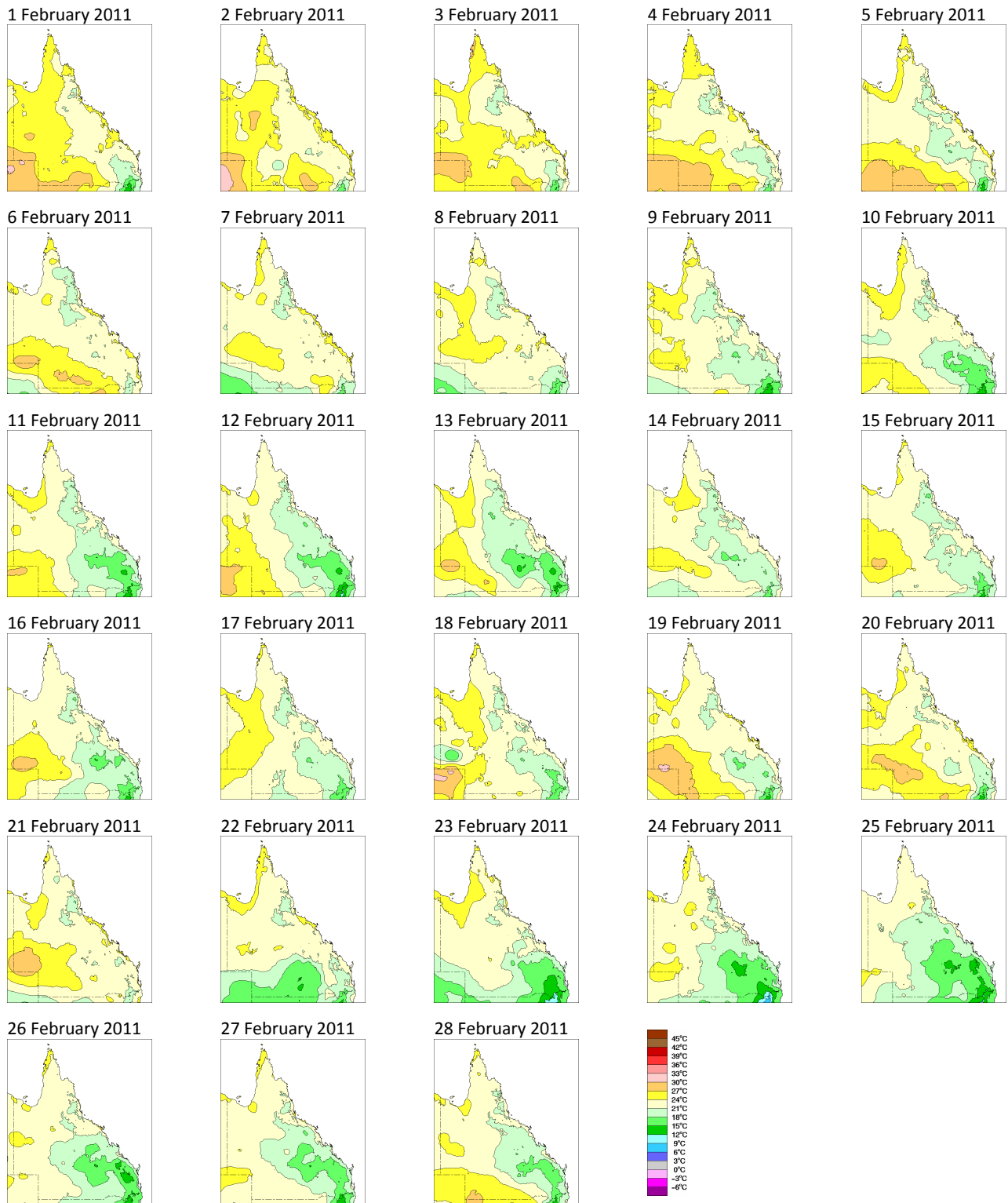

## Daily maximum temperature for February 2011



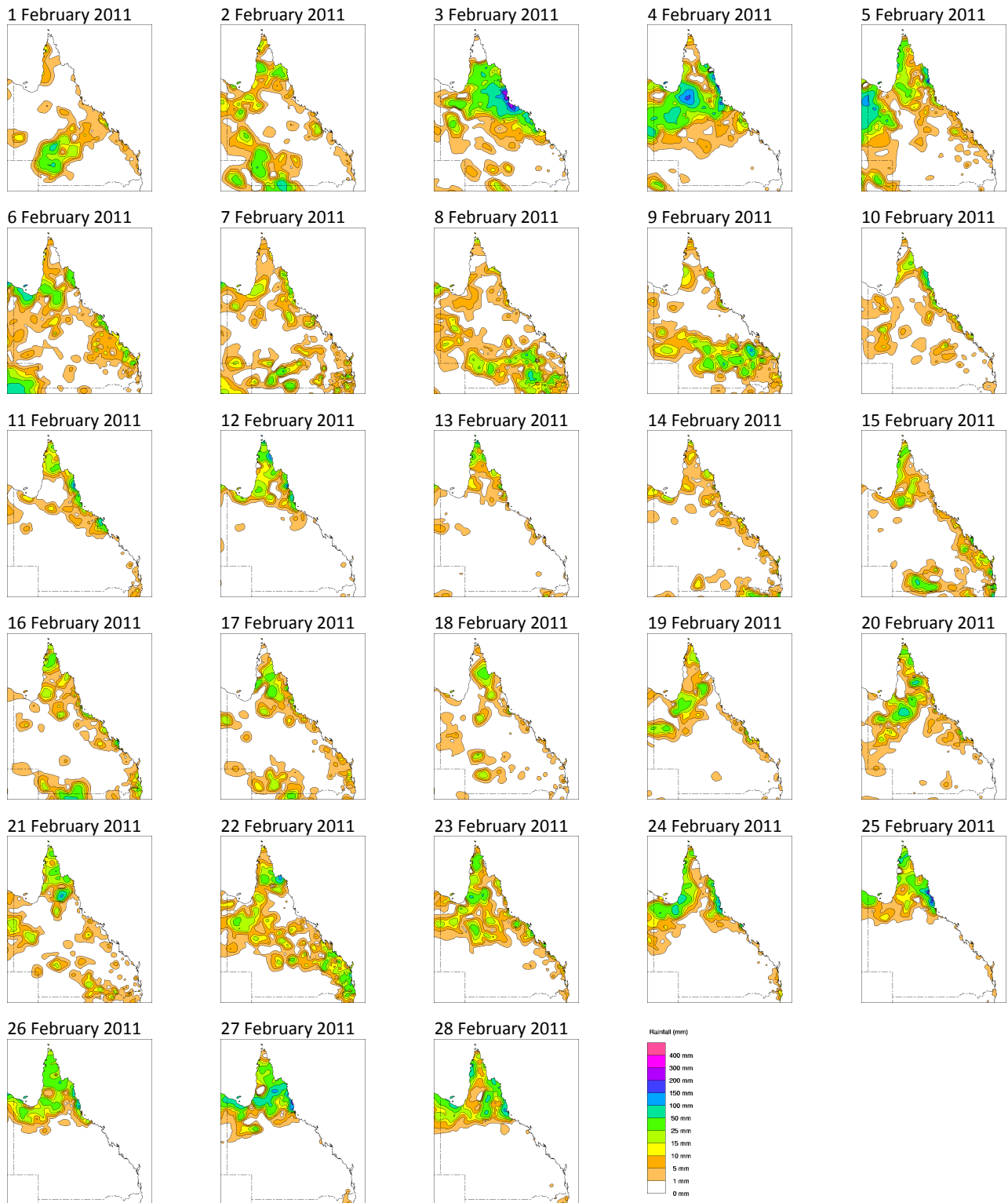
