Conditions of Use

(i) The Bureau makes no representation and gives no warranty of any kind whether express, implied, statutory or otherwise in respect to the availability, accuracy, currency, completeness, quality, reliability or suitability of the information or that the information will be fit for any particular purpose or will not infringe any third party Intellectual Property rights; and

(ii) the Bureau's liability for any loss, damage, cost or expense resulting from use of, or reliance on, the information is entirely excluded.”
